<b>CIN/Clinical Program Introduction and Education</b>	Participating practices must complete CIN and clinical quality program introduction/education sessions as required by the Concert Board of Managers. All sessions will be offered via multiple modalities for ease of completion, i.e., in-person, video, computer-based learning, regular practice meeting, etc.  <i>Rationale: Demonstrates compliance to the FTC through active physician engagement in CIN communication and activities.</i>	Custom
<b>Valid Email Address</b>	Active, valid email address on file for network communications.  <i>Rationale: Provides active means of direct communication between the CIN and participating physicians.</i>	Custom
